Chamber Music Amici, the first resident company of the Richard E. Wildish Community Theater in Springfield, with sold-out concerts since 2009, will perform Peter Schickele's "The Emperor's New Clothes" on June 4, 2011. Peter Schickele is better known as P. D. Q. Bach for his musical spoofs. On June 4, Hans Christian Anderson (actor William Hulings) will tell the original story, and then help Chamber Music Amici and Eugene Ballet present Peter Schickele's hilarious musical update.
